PREREQUISITI	<p>Level B2 of the CEFR</p> <p>Students should be able to understand the main ideas of complex texts on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in their field of specialization; interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party; produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.</p>
RISULTATI DI APPRENDIMENTO ATTESI	<p>Knowledge and Understanding Students will learn the linguistic competences necessary to analyse specialized texts in the field of International Relations. Special emphasis will be given to terminology and the proper use of linguistic features characterizing the language of politics.</p> <p>Applying Knowledge and Understanding Students will apply their knowledge of Discourse Analysis to analyse specialised texts and elaborate papers and original research. In particular, they will be able to identify the linguistic features characterising special texts that will be selected during the course.</p> <p>Making Judgements Students will learn to use methodologies and tools of Discourse Analysis necessary to analyse specialized texts in the fields of International Relations. They will be able to make their own judgments about linguistic peculiarities of specialized texts.</p> <p>Communication Skills Students will be able to present case studies based on relevant literature of Discourse Analysis and Critical Discourse Analysis. They will be able to communicate knowledge and their research results using specialized language and appropriate terminology.</p> <p>Learning Skills Students will be able to select, analyse paragraphs taken from specialised texts in the field of international relations and global political system. They will produce a final thesis on a specific topic selected during the course.</p>
VALUTAZIONE DELL'APPRENDIMENTO	<p>WRITTEN TEST The written test consists of a verb completion, reading comprehension passages and a multiple choice grammar test. It takes 50 minutes and the minimum score required to pass and take the oral part is 60/100.</p> <p>ORAL TEST Students will produce a final thesis on a specific topic selected during the course. During the oral part they will present the results of their research based on relevant literature of Discourse Analysis and Critical Discourse Analysis. They will be able to communicate knowledge and understanding in a fluent and confident way by using specialized language and the referring terminology. Candidates are tested according to the level of their knowledge and fluency and receive an assessment out of thirty as final grade (the pass mark is 18/30).</p>
OBIETTIVI FORMATIVI	<p>The aim of this course is to develop the linguistic competences necessary to analyse specialised texts in the fields of International Relations. Discourse Analysis and Critical Discourse Analysis (CDA) will help students to assess the consequences of proper/improper use of specialised language in the fields of law and policy-making. In writing, students will be able to use the conventions of the communicative task to hold the target reader's attention and communicate straightforward ideas. Students who successfully pass the final exam will get a B2-plus Level in English Language.</p>
