PREREQUISITI	
RISULTATI DI APPRENDIMENTO ATTESI	<p>Knowledge and Understanding Students will learn the linguistic competences necessary to analyse specialized texts in the field of International Relations. Special emphasis will be given to terminology and the proper use of linguistic features characterizing the language of politics.</p> <p>Applying Knowledge and Understanding Students will apply their knowledge of Discourse Analysis to analyse specialised texts and elaborate papers and original researches. In particular, they will be able to identify the linguistic features characterising special texts that will be selected during the course.</p> <p>Making Judgements Students will learn to use methodologies and tools of Discourse Analysis necessary to analyse specialized texts in the fields of International Relations. They will be able to make their own judgments about the linguistic peculiarities of specialized texts.</p> <p>Communication Skills Students will be able to give presentations of case studies based on relevant literature of Discourse Analysis and Critical Discourse Analysis. They will be able to communicate knowledge and research results using specialized language and appropriate terminology.</p> <p>Learning Skills Students will be able to select, analyse specialised texts in the field of international relations and global political system. They will produce a final thesis on a specific topic selected during the course.</p>

OBIETTIVI FORMATIVI	The aim of this course is to develop the linguistic competences necessary to analyse specialised texts in the fields of International Relations. Discourse Analysis and Critical Discourse Analysis (CDA) will help them to assess the consequences of proper/improper use of specialised language in the fields of law and policy-making.
